NITD Statement of Belief:

In order to understand the Tres Dias organization, you must understand what we believe. These beliefs explain our allegiance to the Savior, our dedication to the work of His Kingdom and our stand for absolute truth: As adopted from the Constitution & By-Laws of Tres Dias International, 2.0

1. We believe and profess our faith in one triune God - the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. (Matthew 28:19)
2. We believe and profess that Jesus Christ is the only Savior, and is God in the flesh. (John 1:1, 3:36 & 14:6, and Hebrews 2:17)
3. We believe and profess that the Holy Spirit is God, and is The Lord and Giver of Life Who continues to work today in believers to sanctify, edify, and empower the whole Christian church on earth for His purposes. (Acts 1:8, John 14:26, Romans 8:11, Job 33:4)
4. We believe and profess that the Holy Scriptures are the inspired and completely true Word of God. (II Timothy 3: 16 - 17)
5. We believe and profess that all have sinned and fallen short of the glory of God, that forgiveness of sins is received through confession and repentance, and that our sins are washed away through the blood of Jesus Christ. (Romans 3: 23, Acts 2: 38 and I John 1:9)
6. We believe and profess that salvation is a gift of God's grace received through personal faith in Jesus Christ. (Ephesians 2:8)
7. We believe and profess that the Body of Christ is to make every effort to keep the unity of the Spirit through the bond of peace until we all reach unity in the faith and in the knowledge of the Son of God. (Ephesians 4:3, 13)
8. We believe and profess that God's unconditional love, as made manifest to us through Jesus Christ, is the primary witness by which people are renewed, edified and changed. (I Corinthians 13:8)
9. We believe and profess that God has called us to live holy lives that will bring glory to His name. (Colossians 3: 1 - 25)

Note: for purposes of standard and principles Tres Dias ascribe to these stated in the "Authorized King James Version" of the Bible of 1611 (KJV).

1. Declare my personal relationship with Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior.
2. Agree with the NITD Statement of Belief.
3. Am an active participant in Tres Dias activities, including attendance at Sequelas, sponsoring and supporting weekends with palanca.
4. Am living the Tres Dias method, including participation in my church and in a reunion group or other small sharing group.
5. Am willing to submit to the authority of the NITD Secretariat through the leadership of the Rector, follow the Essentials of Tres Dias and the Dynamics of the Weekend and abide by the NITD Bylaws and Policies and Procedures.
6. Have attended a Tres Dias or equivalent adult weekend.
7. Am willing to pray regularly for the team and candidates.
- 8. Am willing to attend all team meetings.**
9. Am willing to follow up with the Candidates in their Fourth Day.
10. Am gladly committed to show my love for the Lord Jesus Christ and His word by pledging to obey Jesus and the scriptures in all aspects of my beliefs, speech and actions. This does not mean that we will be perfect in this life before we can serve on team! Rather, this means that we are committed to a lifestyle of renouncing sin, seeking forgiveness and healing, and pursuing/growing in the direction of Godliness; that we will "love the Lord with all our heart, soul, mind, and strength" (Mark 12:30). Among others, Godly standards include the following:

Godly people acknowledge our duty to love people as God has loved us, but also that authentic love is based on biblical truth and does not condone or justify any wrongful ways of the world (John 13:34-35, John 3:16, Luke 6:27, 1 John 2:15-16, 1 Corinthians 13:4-6)

Godly people are good citizens who respect authority and law (Romans 13:1-7)

Godly people do not drink to drunkenness or use illegal drugs. (1 Corinthians 6:9-10, Galations 5:19-21)

Godly people do not advocate or engage in sexual activities before or outside marriage between a man and a woman (Genesis 2:24, 1 Corinthians 6:9, 7:8-9, Hebrews 13:4, Romans 1:24-27)

Godly people acknowledge that we are created and born either male or female and that denial of our given sex and gender or an attempt to change it desecrates the image of God (Genesis 1:27)

Godly people choose their words carefully, refrain from vulgar language and crude jokes, and speak truth that builds others up. In all things, we seek to support one in another in grace and truth, as together we help one another toward the goal of being transformed to be like Christ. (Proverbs 29:20, Proverbs 13:3, James 3:2-10, James 1:26, Ephesians 5:4, Ephesians 4:29).
